Good afternoon SJS Community,

Today our school community celebrated and commissioned our Grade 8 students at Medal Mass. Each 8th Grader received a St. John the Evangelist medal and was asked/challenged to be an evangelizer like St. John. This means spreading the good news of the gospel. There is no better way to do this than to show love for all through service. This is the way of St. John School and the legacy of the Sisters of St. Joseph. We are proud of our 20 8th graders and are excited to celebrate this year with them. It was also a great blessing to have the return of our youth choir to Mass.

I wanted to provide a quick review of attendance codes at SJS. We use four codes – P for present, PER for present released early, T for tardy, and TPD for tardy partial day (after 9:00 am). We do not distinguish between excused and unexcused. At the end of each Term, we do a review of students who have hit the threshold of 10% days absent/early release and/or tardy (10% is the typical threshold for truancy). After Term 1, students/families over the 10% threshold will get a letter from me. If this continues into Term 2, we set up an in-person meeting. We believe that in-school time is precious and want to protect it. We do, however, understand extenuating health circumstances and take them into account.

One last note - there was an error in previous emails concerning the end time of NJHS tutoring. Pick up is at the Main Entrance at 4:15.
