We are pleased to announce that Canton Public Schools will be providing transportation services to St John's School for the 2024-25 school year. Bus Rider Categories

Category #1. Students grades K- 6, who live more than 2 miles from the school they attend, OR cross or walk on Route 138 (safety), will be transported without a fee.

Category #2. Students in grades K-6, who live less than 2 miles from the school they attend, are eligible to apply and pay for the Pay and Ride Program.

Category #3. All students in grades 7-12 (regardless of distance) are eligible to apply and pay for Pay and Ride Program

Transportation Fees

If you are required to pay a transportation fee for your child(ren), the fees are as follows:

\$300.00 for the first child

\$285 for the second child

\$265 for the third child

Family cap of \$850.00

All fees are subject to change by vote of the Canton School Committee.

Each child is eligible for one seat on one bus. If you require a child to be picked up and dropped off at an additional location requiring a second bus, you will need to purchase a second seat at regular price. Please contact the transportation office at 781-821-5060 x1156 for more information.

Application Due Dates

All applications must be submitted by June 7th, 2024. Applications received after June 7, 2024 will not be processed until October, 1 2024. No exceptions!

Payment Options and Information

a. Mailing Check Payment

- ii. Clearly print your student's name(s) and St. John somewhere on the check or on separate paper. If you do not add this information, the checks will be returned to you.
