We have a big Service Hours volunteer opportunity for all - Basketball Game Volunteers!

If you don't know, the SJS Basketball program has become quite large and is an exciting part of our school. Each year we host 48 home games over our 12 teams. We rely on parent volunteers to staff the games as Gym Monitors and Snack Stand volunteers. The parent volunteers help make sure things run smoothly during the games, answer questions from opposing teams, and possibly sell snacks.

This year there are 14 different home game dates with 4 volunteer slots for each night (two open the night and two end the night). Our goal is to have two parents on duty who can split the responsibilities. This means we have lots of opportunities to volunteer. Once we have the sign ups filled, we can provide a better overview of the snack shack and how to close the gym (both are relatively simple). As for service hours, you receive the number of service hours you work. If you work a two-hour shift, you receive two service hours.

As with any service opportunities where you might interact with children you must have an active CORI and completed VIRTUS training.
