1. Full size Backpack

2023-24 Middle School Supply List - All Grades

Middle School is the time to find an organizational system that works for your child so they are prepared for High School:

★ Supplies needed each day in school to be carried from class to class:

- **Binder/Main organization system: Suggestions:**
 - Zip Tab 3-Inch Zipper Binder, available from Amazon **OR** Filexec Soft Touch Padded Canvas Window Expanding File, 13 Pockets, 1 Pack, (46221-6) available from Amazon
 - 3 pocket folders (any color or variety of colors)
 - Pencil Pouch(if you don't already have one) **NOT a Box or overly large pouch**. It should fit in the binder or bag
 - 3 Notebooks (English, Literature), & Theology (8 x 11.5 with 3 holes to put in binder)
 - **For 7th Grade only - 1 - One subject composition notebook for ELA**
 - 3 Pens (1 Blue, 1 Black and 1 Red)
 - 2 Pencils #2
 - 2 dry erase markers - any color
 - 1 highlighter (any color)
 - Earbuds for Chromebooks (should be able to be put in pencil case or in Chromebook case and brought to class everyday - *not headphones*)
 - Scientific Calculator(Casio FX-260 solar II - Available through amazon). I only teach this one.
 - “Padded” Chromebook 11.6 to 12” case – **with handle or strap**
 - Hardcover Chromebook cover - If you already have a hard cover for the Chromebook, you can use the same one from last year. Students will get back the same chromebook they have this year, but if you want to buy a new one:
 - **Hard shell for Samsung Chromebook 4 - XE310XBA model - from Amazon**. You can buy any color. You don't have to buy from Amazon, but make sure that the one you buy is compatible with the **Samsung Chromebook 4 - XE310XBA model** or it won't fit. **All students who will be in 7th grade in the fall need to be a new one. They will be getting a new Chromebook in the fall.**
 - 1 Ruler (metric/U.S. standard)
 - 10-20 sheets of loose leaf paper for homework

★ Supplies to left in locker, to use as needed:

- Extra pens, pencils, highlighters, dry erase markers, and a pack of white-lined paper

★ Supplies to be left at home for homework and projects:

- Pens, pencils, highlighters, white-lined paper, scissors, tape, colored pencils, markers, 1 ruler (metric/U.S. standard), a stapler, and graph paper(1/4” square)

★ Supplies for Art class, to be kept in a zip-loc bag at school

- 2 black sharpie/permanent markers - fine tip and, 2-3 sharpened pencils with extra erasers

★ Each homeroom teacher will email you in August as to what specific classroom supplies are needed
