

## Tuition Assistance Policy

St. John School gives out financial aid to families in need. This money comes from three different sources.

- St. John School Endowment - \$20,000
- Catholic Schools Foundation - \$10,000
- St. Vincent DePaul - varies from year to year (\$3,000-\$4,500)

St. John School goal is for at least 10% of students and/or families to receive aid. Aid ranges from \$500 - \$2,000 per student. St. John School uses a committee made up of the principal, the administrative assistant, and the business manager to make decisions.

St. John School also tries to leave a small amount of aid available for emergencies throughout the year. In addition, St. John School utilizes the Catholic Schools Foundation Emergency Fund when possible.

This financial aid is given out to families who apply through FACTS and are verified. St. John School uses the following criteria for awarding financial aid:

1. FACTS recommendation
2. Multiple students at St. John School
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> year or greater at St. John School
4. Significant family crisis
5. Alumni family
