Good afternoon St. John School,

Catholic Schools Week is next week. This is a time to celebrate Catholic education around the nation. Please see below for details on the week.

This week we began rapid at home testing with teachers. We had 39 teachers and staff sign up and this testing caught two COVID cases. This shows that rapid at home testing is effective in preventing COVID in our school. Next week we will begin rapid at home testing for students. If you have not opted into rapid at home testing, please take the opportunity at https://forms.gle/uZJ1LUY33ujDa6H57.

Next week we will end our test to stay program and contact tracing. I will email you on the day we make this shift (it will be the day that we receive our student at home rapid tests). Our remote option will revert to its original policy on Tuesday, February 1, which means that only COVID positive students may access Zoom. Also on Tuesday, vaccinated students who are close contacts outside of school will be allowed in school.

Term 2 report cards went out this afternoon via RenWeb. You should have received an email. Report cards can also be accessed through the RenWeb Family Portal. Congratulations to our Term 2 Middle School Honor Roll students – see attached.

I want to offer another reminder about drop off and pick up, particularly as the weather worsens. For drop off, if you are walking your child to the Main Entrance, a parent must walk all the way to the front door with their child. We also have rolling drop so once you turn with the gym to your right side, students should exit their car. For middle school pick up, parents must park, leave their car, and walk over to the grass to pick up their child. No middle schooler may walk in the parking lot unattended.

My final reminder – please make sure your child has appropriate winter clothing. This includes a warm coat, hat, and gloves. We will be going outside as often as we can. If your child wears boots to school, they must also bring appropriate shoes to change in to in the building.
